

2015 SUPL Photowalk

Every couple of years, the global particle physics collaboration *Interactions Collaboration* (www.interactions.org) holds a Photowalk competition where amateur and professional photographers are given the opportunity to go behind the scenes at a particle physics laboratory to areas usually inaccessible to the public. At each participating laboratory, photographers are asked to submit their best pictures. A panel of local judges selects their favourites for local prizes and exhibitions, and for submission to the Global Photowalk Competition run by the Interactions Collaboration.

The Stawell Underground Physics Laboratory (SUPL) Photowalk will be held on Friday 25 September 2015 and will allow up to seven photographers the unique opportunity to take images of a particle physics laboratory in its nascent stage of development.

Participating laboratories and organisations in the 2015 Global Photowalk include CERN (Switzerland), DESY (Germany), Fermilab (USA), KEK (Japan), TRIUMF (Canada), SLAC (USA), INFN (Italy) and SUPL (Australia).

Guidelines

1. You must be 18 years of age to participate in the SUPL Photowalk
2. Only photographers with confirmed registration will be able to participate in the SUPL Photowalk on September 25 2015.
3. You must wear closed-toed shoes without high heels.
4. All participants must fill out and sign a photo release form to submit the photos taken during the event to the local and global contest.
5. Participants must adhere to all safety rules and follow the instructions given to you by your Photowalk guide. The touching and rearranging of equipment is absolutely forbidden.
6. Participants must stay with your assigned Photowalk group and guide at all times, within the assigned areas.
7. Large rolling cases are not allowed. All participants must carry all necessary equipment on their person at all times. Assistants will also not be permitted.
8. Participants will not be allowed to plug in any electrical devices during the walk. Make sure you have enough charged batteries to last you for the entire event.
9. The use of long cords (flash cords, sync cables, camera releases) that could be a trip hazard will not be allowed.
10. The use of tripods is allowed.

Terms and Conditions:

You retain all of your ownership rights to images taken by you at the “SUPL Photowalk”. However, by registering for the “SUPL Photowalk”, you hereby grant CoEPP (ARC Centre of Excellence for Particle Physics at the Terascale), SUPL (Stawell Underground Physics Laboratory) and the Interactions Collaboration a worldwide, non-exclusive, royalty-free, sublicenseable and transferable license to use, reproduce, distribute, prepare derivative works of and display the images in connection with CoEPP, SUPL and Interactions including without limitation for promoting and redistributing part or all of the images (and derivative works thereof) in any media formats and through any media channels. The above licenses granted by you are perpetual and irrevocable.

CoEPP, SUPL and Interactions do not permit copyright infringing activities and infringement of intellectual property rights on its website and websites under its auspices, and will disqualify images if properly notified that such content infringes on another’s intellectual property rights. CoEPP, SUPL and Interactions reserve the right to remove content from their websites without prior notice.

All images taken at the SUPL Photowalk will undergo an initial approval process by Stawell Gold Mines (Crocodile Gold Corp). Until such time as approval is received, publishing of images is prohibited.

Each entrant will be able to submit a minimum of five and a maximum of ten images for the local (SUPL Photowalk) competition. Selected images will be entered into an international (Global Photowalk) competition sponsored by the Interactions Collaboration.

The decision of the judges is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Registering for the SUPL Photowalk will be taken to mean acceptance of these terms and conditions.
