The ARC Centre of Excellence for Particle Physics at the Terascale (CoEPP) is a collaborative research venture between the Universities of Melbourne, Adelaide, Sydney and Monash University. Through the Centre, terascale, high-energy particle physics research across Australia is coordinated, bringing together theoretical physicists with experimental physicists who work on the ATLAS experiment.

From 2016, CoEPP will offer up to 4 scholarships annually for eligible students beginning their Honours year or Masters by Coursework at any node of the Centre with an annual scholarship of \$5,000 for one or two years, dependent on the length of their studies. Students required to move interstate to undertake their studies can also apply for an additional \$5,000 in their first year to assist with relocation.

Fields of study:

Honours or Masters by Coursework in which the research project component is in either experimental particle physics or theoretical particle physics at one of the Centre's node universities.

Value

\$5,000 per year for each year of full-time study for the duration of the course. An additional \$5,000 relocation allowance can be provided in the first year for students moving interstate in order to undertake their studies.

Number on offer

Up to one per node university per year will be offered.

Selection criteria and process

Eligibility

The scholarship will be available to both Domestic and International students who are accepted into an Honours year, or Masters by Coursework at a Centre-node university and will undertake full-time study

Selection basis

Selection will be based on a combination of academic merit and/or financial need.

Application process

All students wishing to be considered for this scholarship must complete this application form.

Applicants graduating from a non-CoEPP university will need to attach a copy of their final year academic transcript to this application.

Applicants wishing to be considered for a relocation allowance will need to submit a short statement of support.

The scholarship (and the relocation assistance if applicable) will be paid in two separate and equal installments after each semester census date.

Subsequent payments after the first payment are subject to satisfactory academic progress.
